Board members,

There's a brewing issue that I want to raise in advance of next week's board meeting. This subject is important enough to warrant advance preparation of the topic.

For those who may not be aware, DraftKings is offering single-event contests for NASCAR, PGA and MMA. Those contests are not in compliance with the carve-out language in UIGEA. And, since DraftKings is not in compliance with UIGEA, they're not in compliance with the FSTA's paid-entry contest operator charter.

Last week, the compliance committee took up the subject, and a spirited conversation ensued. There are several issues, but at the highest level, a disagreement exists about whether the UIGEA should be part of the FSTA's charter. The minutes from the meeting are attached. The minutes will let everyone learn more about the issues at hand, and it's also important for transparency.

Jason and Nigel represent two sides of the disagreement. If either of you feel that it would be helpful to inform the board of your stance on these topics in advance of Thursday's meeting, feel free to do so.

That said, I'm specifically not looking to start an email discussion over this topic. I think that discussion is best left for Thursday's call.

Thursday's meeting looks like it will be pivotal, and I highly recommend that everyone attend, and allot extra time for the call.
