And on reading the affidavit of Ann Henry filed on the 30th day of May 2016 and the documents and exhibits therein referred to including the Request for International Judicial Assistance dated the 27st day of May 2016, executed by the Honourable Justice Saliann Scarpulla of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, from which it appears that the above titled proceedings are pending before the Supreme Court of the State of New York in the United States of America and that such tribunal is desirous of obtaining the testimony of Peter Roberts of Roberts Nathan, Business Advisers and Accountants (“**Roberts Nathan**”) and Victoria Henkelmann, Theophanis Philippou, Helen O’Donovan and Liam Grainger being current and former directors of Coral Petroleum Limited (“**Coral**”), or in the alternative, such employee(s) or agent(s) as are nominated as an appropriate witness(es) by Robert Nathans and/or Coral

And on hearing said Counsel.

IT IS ORDERED that: -

- (i) Recognition and effect be given to the Request for International Judicial Assistance made by way of Letters Rogatory (the “Request”) made to this Honourable Court by the Supreme Court of the State of New York, Commercial Division, on 27 May 2016, pursuant to Section 1 of the Foreign Tribunals Evidence Act, 1856 and/or Order 39, Rule 39 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (as amended).
- (ii) Peter Roberts of Roberts Nathan, and Victoria Henkelmann, Theophanis Philippou, Helen O’Donovan and Liam Grainger being current and former directors of Coral, or in the alternative, such employee(s) or agent(s) as are nominated as an appropriate witness(es) by Robert Nathans and/or Coral, do attend before Eileen Barrington, SC (the “Examiner”) at the offices of Philip Lee Solicitors, 7/8 Wilton Place, Dublin 2 as soon as is reasonably practicable or at such other place or on such other date as may be agreed between the parties and the said Examiner not later than 29 July 2016, and do there submit to be examined upon oath or affirmation upon the matters specified in the Request and do produce, at least 30 days in advance of such examination, the documents as specified at clause 11 of the Request. The registered office of Roberts Nathan is at Fourth Floor, The Atrium, Blackpool Business Park, Cork. The registered office of Coral is at 1st Floor, 10 – 11 Exchange Place, IFSC, Dublin 1.
- (iii) Gwen Malone Stenography Services, and/or such other stenography services provider as may be appointed by the parties and the Examiner, do transcribe (and where necessary to translate) the evidence of each witness according to the rules and practice of this Honourable Court pertaining to the examination and cross-examination of a witness(es) and do cause such witness to sign his/her deposition in the presence of the Examiner and to sign the deposition himself/herself.
- (iv) Legal Multimedia Services or such other videography services provider as may be appointed by the parties and the Examiner, do video the evidence of each witness according to the rules and

practice of this Honourable Court pertaining to the examination and cross-examination of a witness(es).

- (v) Counsel for the Defendants or another attorney of the law firm Quinn Emanuel Urquhart & Sullivan LLP or White & Case LLP, do put the questions described in the Request to the witness(es) and ask questions arising, directly or indirectly, from the answers given, with the assistance of an Irish Barrister or in an Irish Court, if necessary.
- (vi) Counsel for the Plaintiff or another attorney of the law firm Steptoe & Johnson LLP, do put the questions described in the Request to the witness(es) and ask questions arising, directly or indirectly, from the answers given, with the assistance of an Irish Barrister or in an Irish Court, if necessary.
- (vii) Each witness of Roberts Nathan and of Coral be directed to give sworn testimony attesting to the authenticity of any documents produced in advance of the examination and confirming that they were maintained in the ordinary course of business or requiring such witness(es) or other duly appointed representative Roberts Nathan or of Coral be required to provide a written declaration certifying the authenticity of any such documents and confirming that they were maintained in the ordinary course of business.
- (viii) Philip Lee do transmit the deposition(s), duly signed by the witness(es) and certified by the Examiner, together with this Order to Stephen Broome of Quinn Emanuel Urquhart & Sullivan LLP, on behalf of the Honourable Saliann Scarpulla, of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, Commercial Division.
- (ix) If necessary, the Examiner be directed to transmit the deposition(s), duly signed by the witness(es) and certified by the Examiner, together with this Order, to the Master of the High Court, for transmission to the Honourable Saliann Scarpulla, of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, Commercial Division.
