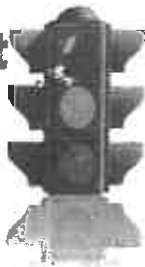

Please take notice that, as the owner and/or registrant of the vehicle appearing in the photo below, you are liable to pay a fine in the amount indicated above. Pursuant to Section 1111-b of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and Suffolk County, New York Local Law 20-2009, you are liable for the fine because, at the date, time and location indicated above, the driver of your vehicle, in violation of Section 1111(d) of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, did not stop for a red light. You must pay your fine by the payment due date indicated above. The fine amount is \$50. There is a \$25 fee for delinquent payments. In addition, a \$30 Administrative Fee will be added for violations occurring on or after April 1st, 2013. Please read the reverse side of this Notice for further instructions.

The pictures shown above contain all needed information, such as: the date and time of the violation; approximate speed of the vehicle; amber time for the light prior to the violation; how long the light was red at the time of the violation; what lane the violation occurred in; the frame sequence of the photos; and the location of the violation. A violation of New York Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1111(d) has been captured by the images on the reverse side of this document. The red light cameras are installed to deter motorists from committing red light violations. The enclosed images were taken automatically by such red light safety cameras. The red light safety camera is only active when the traffic light is red, not when the light is green or yellow.

Vehicles crossing the stop line or entering the crosswalk after the light turns red are detected automatically. In addition to a video, the camera takes two photographs, resulting in three images approximately one second apart. These images show the date and time of the violation, as well as other pertinent information.

When a red light offense is photographed, the owner and/or registrant are mailed a Notice of Liability. The owner and/or registrant are legally liable to pay the fine, currently \$50.00, but will not receive points on his or her license. In addition, a \$30.00 Administrative Fee is assessed for all violations. Failure to respond by the due date will be considered an admission of liability, and a default judgment will be entered against you and may result in an additional \$25.00 penalty. **THIS FINE IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY DISCRETIONARY REDUCTIONS.**

The owner and/or registrant will be held legally liable for violations even if he/she was not the driver of the vehicle at the time of the violation.

INSTRUCTIONS

ONLINE PAYMENT: The fastest and easiest way to pay your fine is to pay online. Go to <http://www.public.cite-web.com> and log on with your Citation # and Pin # shown in the red box on the front of this Notice. A \$4.00 processing fee will be assessed for each credit card transaction. Credit cards accepted are Visa/MasterCard/Discover.

PAYMENT BY PHONE: Call 866-637-0008 and follow the automated prompts. Please have your citation number and credit card ready (Visa/MasterCard/Discover). A \$4.00 processing fee will be assessed for each credit card transaction.

PAYMENT BY MAIL: Check or money order should be made payable to: **Suffolk County Treasurer**. Mail your payment and remittance stub in the enclosed envelope to: Suffolk County Red Light Safety Program, PO Box 778, Baltimore, MD 21203-0778. Write the citation number and license plate number on your check or money order to ensure proper credit. Returned checks are subject to electronic redeposit for the face amount and a returned check fee of \$20.00. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**

PAY IN PERSON: Cash, check or money order payments can be made in person at: Suffolk County Traffic and Parking Violations Agency, H. Lee Dennison Building, 100 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, NY 11788, Mon-Fri 9:00AM – 12:30PM and 2:00PM – 4:30PM, except holidays.

VIEW YOUR IMAGES AND VIDEO: The recorded images and video of the violation will be submitted as evidence in the Adjudication hearing for disposition of the violation. You may view your images and video online at <http://www.public.cite-web.com>. You will need your Citation # and Pin # printed on the front of this Notice inside the red box. If you do not have internet access, you may view your video and images at your local public library.

THERE ARE TWO WAYS TO CONTEST THIS VIOLATION:

This ticket is not subject to discretionary reduction. You cannot plead to a lesser offense, and the fine cannot be reduced.

(1) You may contest the imposition of this fine by signing and mailing the remittance notice below to request an appearance before the Suffolk County Traffic and Parking Violations Agency. Your request must be received by the due date stated on the front of this Notice. Upon receipt, you will be notified of the date, time and location of your hearing.

OR

(2) If the basis of your claim is that your vehicle or license plates were stolen at the time of the infraction, attach a certified copy of the police report
