
PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is an action and proceeding commenced pursuant to Article 78 and Article 30 of the Civil Practice Law and Rules (CPLR) and upon the annexed Petition, verified on the 21st day of September, 2018, an application will be made to the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of Albany, at the County Courthouse located at 16 Eagle Street, Albany New York, 12207 on the 26th day of October, 2018 at 9:30 in the forenoon or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard for a judgment pursuant to CPLR §§ 7803(3), 7803(4), 7805 and 7806:

1. to annul, vacate and void the portion the November 17, 2017 order of the New York Public Service Commission ("PSC") in case 17-M-0178 (as well as the PSC's May 21, 2018 order denying rehearing of the November 17, 2017 order of the PSC) that ordered
 - The further implementation of Advanced Metering Infrastructure ("AMI") throughout Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc.'s ("O&R") entire service territory.
 - The funding for the implementation of Advanced Metering Infrastructure ("AMI") throughout O&R's entire service territory.
 - The continuation of AMI deployment by O&R in Rockland County and further funding for AMI deployment in Rockland County.

- The continuation of expansion of AMI deployment by O&R into Orange and Sullivan Counties and further funding for AMI deployment in Orange and Sullivan County.
 - The continuation of customer engagement activities regarding AMI.
2. or in the alternative, to allow the results of the Westchester pilot program to be vetted at a public hearing and to allow a pilot in Rockland County in an area that had smart meters before the further rollout was approved to occur with the results then being vetted at a public hearing before allowing further rollout of AMI meters.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to CPLR §403(b), Respondents' answer and supporting affidavits, if any, shall be served upon the attorney for the petitioners at least seven (7) days prior to the return date of this matter.
