Steve,

Good afternoon

You have a lot of ideas and desires that are imposing on me and the Court by complicating matters, and you ignore my discovery request to get to the facts. Below is your latest list.

Pls don't complicate matters. I am as of now Pro Se in the traverse hearing. You can agree to withdraw you motion to hold it or give me the discovery I requested. YOu are refusing to do either. Please confirm this to me personally and directly. no need to include mitch.

1. You have a pending motion to vacate the traverse hearing, a formal request for a 15-day adjournment via email (which you reconfirmed during today's hearing), and a final decision from Justice Cohen cancelling tomorrow's hearing.
2. We have said all along that we were ready to proceed tomorrow, but you insisted that you had a conflict of interest with your lawyer and needed to retain co-counsel.
3. Whatever the case may be, the Court relied upon those representations and removed the hearing from the calendar.
4. Despite our best efforts to finalize a settlement, you have continuously papered the record with misleading and self-serving emails, and even apprised Justice Cohen that you would not withdraw pending papers that are predicated upon several admittedly false statements.
5. You also continue to bombard me with contradictory, harassing, and vexatious demands.
6. Accordingly, I will not be responding to you directly going forward.
7. I will be happy to continue communications with Mitch or your new co-counsel once you finalize their representation, and

8. look forward to providing the Court with mutually agreeable dates on which to reschedule the traverse hearing pursuant to Justice Cohen's instructions.
