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UPON the annexed Affirmation of Jeffrey M. Eilender, Esq. dated March 6, 2018 (which also constitutes the Emergency Affirmation of Jeffrey M. Eilender), and upon the pleadings and proceedings heretofore had herein,

LET Defendant Richard W. 
