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CHARLES J. HARDER, an attorney licensed to practice before the courts of this State, hereby affirms the following under penalty of perjury:

1. I am an active member of the New York Bar and counsel for Petitioner Robert S. Trump in this action.

2. Petitioner is moving for a temporary restraining order against Respondents Mary L. Trump and Simon & Schuster, Inc. who have announced their intention to publish a book that violates the terms of a 2001 settlement agreement executed by her.

3. We learned of the intentions of Respondents on or about June 16, 2020, and promptly brought this matter to this Court's attention.

4. This matter must be heard forthwith, as the release date for the book has been set for July 28, 2020, and the nature of the book publishing industry is such that copies of books ship to bookstores, and review copies are distributed, in advance of publication.

5. On June 22, 2020, I e-mailed counsel for Mary Trump, and the legal department of Simon & Schuster, and gave notice of the Queens Surrogate's Court proceeding. Further, counsels received a full set of papers when I served them in the previous Queens Surrogate's Court proceeding. I further emailed counsel for Mary Trump and Simon & Schuster, and gave

notice of this proceeding early this morning. A true copy of this e-mail is attached here as

6. No prior application for the relief requested herein has been made other than the application to the Queens Surrogate's Court which was rejected for lack of subject matter jurisdiction.
